Minutes of Previous Meeting:

Minutes were circulated by mail prior to this meeting (and additional copies tabled at this meeting 13/09/04).

Bill Earwaker/Bob Gibbs - That the minutes of the 14/06/04 meeting as circulated and tabled at this meeting 13/09/04 be accepted as a correct record - Passed.

Matters arising from minutes:

Correspondence:

Waste placement:

Chris Northey described refuse placement taking place in Phase 11 since May 2004. Disposal operations will shift to high in the north and east from October until late in the year/early in the New Year. Placement of Final Cover will follow immediately thereafter and the area will be grassed.

Planting:

Chris Northey reported the Phase 10 bund re-planting was completed in early July.

Some additional planting is scheduled for those areas not completed in the Southern Bulge area (earth works were not completed). Richards Road boundary has been identified for plantings in the new year.

Site development:

Chris Northey reported a moderate construction program is planned for November to March 2005. This is largely sub-liner placement in preparation for cell liner construction October 2005 to April 2006.

Power:

Mr Gibbs enquired regarding LFGTE power reticulation to the grid. Chris Wills advised 3 MW is reticulated via the 33kV line and 1 MW via 11kV. Chris also gave a brief analysis of the spot market mechanism and the extent to which WAM reticulation supports the local network. Mick Hunt observed outages were much reduced in number.

Chris Wills briefly canvassed some technological advances within the sector including wind power ("no wind-no power" and 1 to 1.5 million dollars per MW capital cost), and combined cycle installations ("can achieve up to 50% of energy transfer, gas to electricity").

Chris W also "flagged" the likelihood of a generator house structure in due course.

Current issues:

Mr Gibbs requested an update on Redvale Lime Company program for disestablishment.

Chris Wills responded that mid-2005 seemed likely.

Peer Review:

Chris Gulliver tabled Peer Review panel Report No 23. A copy is attached to these minutes.

Current Issues:

Chris Wills spoke to a number of matters:

- the foot-print variation (a.k.a. Southern Bulge) consenting process is well advanced.
- the northern motorway extension may require structural fill material from site.
- WAM is continuing discussions with Snow Planet regarding a "Wheeling Agreement".
- we are looking to replace the leachate storage tanks at the flare station.

General business:
