**Minutes of Previous Meeting:**

Minutes were circulated by mail prior to this meeting (and additional copies tabled at this meeting 14/06/04).

Bill Earwaker/Mike Kunzli - That the minutes of the 15/03/04 meeting as circulated and tabled at this meeting 14/06/04 be accepted as a correct record - Passed.

**Matters arising from minutes:**

Bill Earwaker sought additional information regarding planting of the Phase 10 Bund. Chris Wills responded accordingly.

**Correspondence:**

None.

**Waste placement:**

Chris Northey described the refuse filling taking place in the (recently completed) Phase 11. His expectation is to fill in Phase 11 until late in the year.

**Planting:**

Chris Northey reported the Phase 10 bund re-planting is scheduled to begin before month end and be completed in early July. A good depth of top-soil is in place to ensure the seedlings thrive.

**Site development:**

No substantial civil works are scheduled over the winter months.

**Complaints:**

The complaints received since the last meeting were discussed.

Rob Burgess observed that litter management on SH 17 was somewhat improved over recent months.

Mike Kunzli described recent incidence of LFG odour in “pockets” on Richards Road and Horseshoe Bush Road. Chris W suggested the seasonal phenomenon of temperature inversion layers contributes to this effect.

**Power:**

Chris Wills informed the meeting that new generators and 33kV line were operable. 3 MW is reticulated via the 33kV line and 1 MW via 11kV.

Mike Kunzli and Rob Burgess have observed no associated noise nuisance.

**Current issues:**

Chris Wills spoke to WMNZ’s application to increase vehicle numbers at Redvale. The application had been granted and the limit extended to 325 vehicles per day.

Chris also apprised the meeting of developments with the Trotting Club. WAM had originally purchased the track for development as a truck park. This option was under consideration.

**Peer Review:**

No new business.

**General business:**

Bill Earwaker initiated some discussion regarding resource recovery and recycling, and the associated impacts on Redvale operations. Chris Wills suggested that, historically, there have been problems with making resource recovery “pay”. The economic buoyancy of the Auckland region was such that reductions in the total waste stream through recovery and recycling were “off-set” by growth in the overall market.
