Minutes of Previous Meeting:

Minutes were circulated by mail prior to this meeting. Minutes of the previous meeting were accepted as correct (moved Kirk, seconded Ross).

Matters arising from minutes:

No items were raised.

Correspondence:

Operations report:

Complaints: The complaints received from neighbours since 15 March 2010 were tabled and discussed. There was extensive discussion on Army Bay sludge which was a particular nuisance and had caused odour complaints in Horseshoe Bush Rd.

Current Issues:

Property: Chris noted that there was an Agreement in place on the Scott property.

Bioreactor: There was no discussion.

Gas supply to greenhouse: This is proceeding well.

G12 – G20 expansion: The consent process was occurring and there were communications with the ARC who had raised a number of questions. The land use consent for expansion of the number of engines was also to be sought.

Biofuel proposals: There were some teething issues currently with the pilot plant. TPI was looking at bringing up a truck from Wellington to run on the gas from the biofuel plant after compression of the gas as a trial.

Recycling plant proposals: This project had been put on hold due the large amount of capital required.

Restructuring: Chris outlined the new TPI structure with the current TPI attendees to the Community meetings remaining unchanged.

General Business:

- There was some discussion on biosolid disposal and disposal onto farmland as an alternative to landfilling.
- Ross discussed communication in regard to the Army Bay sludge issue and noted that he would like to be included and represent Redvale's point of view at the proposed meeting with Downers EDI (RDC contractor operating the Army Bay plant) and RDC.
- Chris Wills will approach Michelle to look into an appropriate date for the Xmas function. It was proposed to have it at the same venue as previous years.
