Welcome: Chris Wills introduced Andy Vosper – Regional Manager Redvale Landfill. Mike Kunzli introduced Debbie Marshall – DF School Principal.

Minutes of Previous Meeting:

Minutes were circulated by mail prior to this meeting.

Matters arising from minutes:

C Wills to visit Tender Rd resident. R Bailey visited and invited resident Mr DeWitt to attend meeting but declined. J McLean has also spoken with the resident to reassure him.

Correspondence:

Operations report

Disposal/Site Development: Rob showed aerial shot of movements and reported currently now planning to launch into phase 18 from adjacent to the access road. Launch pad is to go in and expected to be completed by the end of July. In the meantime bunds are being built up on the upper level to about RL 100.

Managed Fill: Construction completed and currently taking in small amounts. Quiet during winter season.

Site Development: Phase 18 expected to be finished by the end of July. Council sign off to come.

Complaints: Received from neighbours since 19/03/13 distributed. Going forward report is to go from quarter to quarter and wind direction to be shown. Filling at the top of the landfill so very exposed at the moment which is causing odour, but expecting to be down in the bottom at phase 18 by end of July.

R Bailey reported on odour diary from Tender Rd. Have discovered recently certain waste streams mixed together give off an ammonia type smell. List of possible waste streams compiled so staff know which types not to mix and keep separate.

Regulatory issues: N Donovan reported on visit in February when weather was dry and Wetlands were not finished. Notifications of exceedances came thru from Managed Fill to be looked at.

Energy: C Wills reported that the biogas proposal was now on the backburner. Redvale will continue with power generation and have had expressions of interest to take landfill gas from local users. Glasshouses are almost ready to take hot water but would like to continue to take gas.

Stockpile 6: 150,000m³ completed last season. The highest current portion is the maximum (final) level. Looking at starting earlier this year with around 400,000m³ to place.

K Storie reported a lot of truck movements creating more noise. More rigid trucks are being looked at for use, noise levels to be checked and programme of activities to be distributed at the next meeting in October.

M Kunzli reported that M Hunt is happy with current works.

Current Issues

Property: Sib division 'X' has plantings well established and proposal will go to Council to divide into three lots within the next six months.

Generation: B Gibbs reported generator noise became unacceptable about four nights ago. Noise monitoring to have more appropriate sampling points added, in particular at the top of B Gibbs driveway.

Biofuel proposals: Waitoki pipeline project not commercially viable.

Peer Review: Report No. 41 not completed. To be discussed at meeting in October. Looking at Report No. 42 to be a five monthly report instead of six monthly to try and bring reports forward a little.

Leachate Levels: These have been lowered substantially, balanced and kept under control.
Review of leachate levels is underway.

General Business: Thanks to be forwarded to Carl Temm for his contribution to the committee.

C Wills reported now that the landfill is 20 years into operation with just over 9 million tonnes in place, the landfill will not be filled by consent expiry date 1st August 2023. Moving forward Management is starting to look at seeking a time extension. Members will be kept fully informed.

Next meeting: Monday 21st October 2013 starting with a landfill tour at 7.00pm.
