### **Operations report**

**Disposal/Site Development:** Robbie showed on aerial shot of movements and reported currently now filling down low in 17c – will start filling in cell 18 in April/May.

**Managed Fill:** Completed. Powerlines to be sorted then fill will be able to start.

**Site Development:** Construction underway of cell 18 and should have the go ahead by end of April, beginning of May.

**Complaints:** Carl distributed the complaints received from neighbours since 30/11/2012.

John advised he had received a phone call from 99 Tender Rd resident Nick DeWitt over the continuing issues of odour on his property over the summer and asked if some pressure could be applied to getting something done to stop the odours. John gave the explanation that it is mostly due to the very dry summer we are experiencing this year which causes the bacteria to grow causing more odour. Something needs to be done to sort this issue out.

Robbie and other staff are continuing to monitor odours and have never been able to detect any on Mr DeWitt's property and so it is very hard to narrow down what is causing the odour.

Nigel suggested getting them involved by offering them an Odour Diary that they could keep their recordings in for landfill staff to check. Robbie showed an aerial photo of where the property is and agreed to get an Odour Diary to the DeWitt's.

**Regulatory issues:** Nigel reported all is in order but noticed the Wetlands have not been planted yet. Due to the dry weather planting is not scheduled till April/May. More bore holes are being placed on site so monitoring can continue.

**Energy:** Very difficult to extract gas due to dry weather conditions. Need to be careful of not sucking oxygen in.

Leachate had dropped after running LEU thru January & February and very little in March. The LEU started back up this week.

**Stockpile 6:** Final cover and topsoils on by end of April before consent closes. Then landscaping will proceed. Compliance is being checked by Southern Skies.

### **Current Issues**

**Property:** Nil

**Air discharge consent:** Nothing to report

**Biofuel proposals:** Proposals continue over the cleaning of gas for feeding into the line at Waitoki. Gas is currently at 2.3% oxygen but would need to be at .5% plus various consents to go thru before any movement forward.

**Peer Review:** Mark Drury presented report No. 40 which was emailed out with the Agenda.

There is a programme in place to keep the Leachate levels down.

Was reported due to the heat that there are no indication of fires within the landfill and regular monitoring avoids this as adjustments can be made.

Contours – Scoping of the landfill is taken by the advice of the Landfill Operations Manager but is something for the Peer Review to do in due course. Currently there is very good compaction. Nigel will check consent conditions.

It was noted that Rosedale was reshaped at the top well after closing. Would be good to know how this came about.

Some discussion over settlement.

**General Business:** Letter of thanks to go out to Charlie Earwaker for his years of service to the committee.
