**Minutes of Previous Meeting:**

Minutes were circulated by mail prior to this meeting. Minutes of the previous meeting were accepted as correct (moved Richard, seconded Ross).

**Matters arising from minutes:**

Gas supply for green house going well.

**Correspondence:**

None.

**Operations report:**

**Complaints:** The complaints received from neighbours since 14 June 2010 were tabled and discussed.

Army Bay sludge loads have been discontinued as from 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2010.

Chris Wills clarified history of complaints for John McLean.

Rob Bailey explained odour complaint process and sourcing of odour for John McLean.

Mick Hunt requested that TWM goes back to distributing summary of complaints report to members at meeting, as distributed back in August 2008.

**Operations:** New cell to be formed just before Christmas as need more dry weather. Mid Nov to New Year fluff layer & compacted layer to be done. Up to three to four months of filling in this cell.

Final cover on Eastern side. Moving litter fence up. Working inside Eastern batter Jan, Feb & March, to form litter screening from state Hwy 17.

Questioned was raised by John McLean on clean up regarding amount of rubbish blowing into neighbouring properties. Was confirmed that Transfield pick rubbish along State Hwy 17 and due to high winds day after day recently a lot of rubbish collected in the litter fence which snapped some poles and allowed some rubbish to filter thru to neighbouring property. Extra staff helped out with litter picking on the landfill & neighbouring property during this time.

### **Current Issues:**

**Property:** Chris noted that a survey firm had been in contact with him recently & Mike Harvey from ARC with regards to wind kilometre.

Consent from Rodney for Horseshoe Bush Rd property to date taking some 5 1/2 months for council to process and could take up to another six weeks to be completed.

**Bioreactor:** John McLean bought up to date. Consent has been granted.

**Gas supply to greenhouse:** This is proceeding well.

**G12 – G20 expansion:** John McLean bought up to date.

Ross Craig reported a lot of shaking at his property at night. Chris Wills explained there is room for three more flares, the shaking will be reduced once more flares are up and running. Gas must be destroyed 24/7. Gasometer destroys 7 1/2 cubic metres.

**Biofuel proposals:** 44 million of diesel equivalent can come from this.

**L.U.C:** Power generation expansion is done.

**Peer Review Report:** Report handed out to members but due to Mark Drury's apologies from this meeting any questions can be raised at the next formal meeting in 2011.

### **General Business:**

- Richard Croker noted that the next issue of the Dairy Flat Community newsletter is due at the beginning of November and that generally these newsletters need more information on what is happening at the landfill.
- John McLean suggested an open day at the landfill. Rob Bailey advised this has been done in the past.
- Ross Craig thanked members for including him generally, but felt he could have been made better use of with the Army Bay sludge issue as he had advised at the previous meeting.
- Ross Craig noted he would have liked to have known sooner about the boundary adjustment consent for the property at Horseshoe Bush Rd.
- John McLean noted that ARC is closed off as of 31<sup>st</sup> October, but a new Supercity Landfills representative will fill the role of the ARC from this date. Also mentioning that Len Brown would be very interested in hearing of any biofuel/recycling proposals.

**Next meeting:** Christmas function at Northridge Country Lodge 6<sup>th</sup> December at 7pm with bus departing TWM office at 6.15pm.

Meeting in the New Year is tentatively booked for 7:30pm Monday 14<sup>th</sup> March 2011 with a site visit for those interested at 7pm.
