Minutes of Previous Meeting:

Minutes were circulated by mail prior to this meeting. Minutes of the previous meeting (16 June 2007) were accepted as correct (moved Richard, seconded Ross).

Matters arising from minutes:

No items were raised.

Correspondence:

None.

Operations report:

Complaints: The complaints list received at the landfill from June was tabled including a number of odour complaints that occurred during power outages in July.

Refuse filling: Refuse filling is currently directed south easterly towards the flare station. Once there, a new landfill access road for refuse vehicles will be constructed on top of that refuse creating new access to and from the wheelwash area.

Energy: Chris described how power prices have dropped and that using landfill gas for leachate evaporation was the current priority to lower leachate levels within the landfill for construction (phase 16) of the liner tie in.

Current Issues:

Property: No changes.

Bioreactor: Lora advised that the ARC has received a draft on the leachate recirculation proposal for comment.

Exhaust stack: Chris advised that a conclusion was some time away and noted that the heat recovery option increases the concentration of NOx contaminants.

Filling in the western property: The study is continuing in preparation for submission to the ARC.

Peer Review Report:

Mark spoke to the six monthly Peer Review Report (Report to the period to April 2008). There was some discussion on the daily vehicle numbers and how average monthly numbers were more appropriate.

There was also support given to the recirculation of leachate within the landfill which was considered beneficial in hastening waste degradation.

The Peer Review report concluded that Redvale Landfill continues to be well managed.

General Business:

No items were raised.

Xmas function:

It was agreed to have the Xmas function on Wednesday December 10th.
