Minutes of Previous Meeting:

Minutes were circulated by mail prior to this meeting (and additional copies tabled at the meeting).

Wayne Walker/Kirk Storie – That the minutes of the 25/06/07 meeting as circulated and tabled at this meeting be accepted as a correct record – Passed.

Matters arising from minutes:

Deliveries of Exide have been delayed due to stabilisation plant issues in Wellington.

Operations report: (Chris Wills)

Disposal: All disposals into another lift in stage 14 and at the base of 15A preparing the area ready for a move into the top stage of Phase 15A which is currently having sidewall liner constructed.

Site Development: Site development for the summer period focussed on cell development against the Southern limit of the landfill footprint.

Complaints: Sharon Johnston made an odour complaint on 4th August at 10.30am. Wind direction N-NE was inconsistent with complaint location i.e. SE of landfill.

Energy: Waste Management still unsuccessful at gaining any carbon credits from power production. Currently we have 9x IMW generators in place with potential for a total of 20, but returns uncertain and further purchase of more units being re-assessed.

Bob Gibbs mentioned that on a few nights he could hear the noise of the generators. Chris Wills responded that noise testing was planned for the summer period and depending on the results a noise bund could be constructed to the south of the flare station.

Current issues: (Chris Willis)

Property: Subdivision of ex C.Earwaker. Property is awaiting issue of title.

Bioreactor progress: Leachate reinjection consent being worked on by consultants.

Exhaust stack height: Expansion of generation may require additional stack height, this is currently being reviewed by consultants.
