

Community trust

A community trust fund will be set up by Waste Management once the proposed landfill begins accepting waste. The trust will be made up of local representatives, elected by the community, together with a single settler's trustee.

During the life of the proposed landfill, Waste Management will contribute annual funding. The trust's purpose will be to distribute grants for the benefit of the local community.

When Redvale Landfill and Energy Park was established, The Dairy Flat Community Trust was created.

Funding has been allocated to Dairy Flat School, Dairy Flat Hall, Hibiscus Coast Hospice, Dairy Flat Air Scouts, pony clubs and other groups and individuals within the community.

From 1993 to 2018, Waste Management has contributed more than \$2,000,000 to The Dairy Flat Community Trust.
